Trans Tasman Trial

Entry ~ \$5

We will be running one Trans Tasman competition on a standard Trans Tasman course and all dogs are eligible to enter, regardless of class. We encourage you to enter your young dogs, as the earlier in a trialling career we get familiar with this course the more natural it will become for us and our dogs.

The Trans Tasman course will be run on Saturday morning, **starting at 8:30am**.

Arena Trial

Novice Entry ~ \$8.00

The novice class will be held after the Trans Tasman on Saturday.

A final will be held for the novice class, consisting of the top four scoring dogs from the first round.

Improver Entry ~ \$8.00

Open Entry ~ \$10.00

Depending on entries, the Improver and Open classes MAY be held together. IF this is the case, should a dog be entered in both classes, the score from their one run will count towards both classes.

A combined final will be held consisting of the top six scoring dogs entered in the Open class and the top four scoring dogs entered in the Improver class, from the first round. Should a dog qualify for both finals, they will have one run and their score will count towards both classes.

- The Novice class will have a shortened cast.
- The draw will be strictly adhered to.
- Prizes will be awarded to 3rd place in every class and will be made up from sponsorship and entry fees collected.
- Lunch and morning tea will be available on the grounds.
- Camping is available on the grounds for \$5/night, to be paid at the trial. There is a toilet, but no shower or electricity.
