Trans Tasman Event

Judge: Merv Simmonds, SA

A separate Trans Tasman event will be held. The start time will be determined by the number of entries received and a draw will be provided for all competitors.

The top four scoring dogs from the first round will compete in the final and we offer First: \$100 and a bag of Dogpro Plus Second: \$50 and a bag of Dogpro Plus Third: \$25 and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$10 per dog.

Novice Event

Judge: Anthony Ireland, SA

A separate Novice event will be held following the Trans Tasman event.

The top four scoring dogs from the first round will compete in the final and we offer First: \$100, perpetual trophy, trophy to keep, embroidered dog rug and a bag of Dogpro Plus Second: \$50, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus Third: \$25, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$10 per dog.

* These State Championships may start on Thursday 12th, depending on entries received.

State Championships

Judge: John Tuddenham, Victoria

The State Championships will follow the Novice event. This is an Open event (only), however, novice and improver dogs are eligible to enter.

The top ten scoring dogs from the first round will compete in the final and we offer:

First: \$500, perpetual trophy, Patron's trophy, embroidered dog rug and a bag of Dogpro Plus
Second: \$300, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus
Third: \$200, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus
Fourth: \$100, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus
Fifth: \$50, trophy and a bag of Dogpro Plus

Entry fee is \$15 per dog.

We also offer special trophies for the:

- Best cast, lift and draw
- Fastest penning time
- Highest score gained by an Improver dog
- Simmonds Family Trophy for the highest score gained by a South Australian owned (and registered) Novice dog
- Highest score gained by a non SA owned Novice dog
- Highest aggregate gained by three nominated dogs (you may nominate more than one group of dogs for this trophy)

- Payment by a competitor for entry into these trials is an indication of your acceptance of the SAWSDA Constitution, Regulations and Rules, including the Code of Conduct, which is applicable to all activities and areas of the venue. - Competitors must be financial members of the Working Sheepdog Association in the State in which they reside and their dogs must be registered.
- The Council of the SAWSDA Inc. reserves the right to refuse the entries from any person whose conduct or comments are deemed to be detrimental to this competition or to the Association.
- Bitches in oestrus will be permitted to compete. We would appreciate your consideration in keeping them isolated from other competitors' dogs.
- Each trial duration is a maximum of fifteen minutes.
- Novice and Improver dogs are eligible to compete in the State Championships. They will have one run only in the Open section – there is not a separate Improver class.
- The winning of any of the special trophies listed above will not be deemed as winning a trial and will not affect the status of a Novice or Improver dog.
- Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Please make cheques payable to the South Australian Working Sheepdog Association (SAWSDA) and post them to Joanne Flavel, PO Box 338, Meningie, SA, 5264.
